O R D E R

The instant petition filed under Article 32 of the Constitution of India prays for release of the petitioner in the crime registered pursuant to FIR No.RC/DST/2018/A/0004 dated 17.01.2018 registered with Police Station STF, District New Delhi, in respect of offences punishable under Section 120B and Sections 13(2) read with Section 13(1)(b) and 13(1)(d) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.

It is submitted by Mr. Ashish Batra, learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has secured release on bail in said crime and as such the counsel has received instructions to withdraw the instant writ petition.

The petition under Article 32 was completely misconceived. We, therefore, impose costs in the sum of Rs.25000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only), which shall be deposited with the Supreme Court Middle Income Group Legal Aid Society within a week's time and compliance certificate shall be placed on record by the petitioner.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
