**UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R**

**Since, the parties are involved in lot of litigations, the
matters are referred to the Supreme Court Mediation Centre.**

The Supreme Court Mediation Centre shall appoint a Mediator who shall hold the discussions online with the parties so that the parties need not travel.

The first such online meeting shall take place on 17-05-2021.

If there is substantial progress in the talks conducted online then the learned Mediator may request the parties to come for physical discussion after things are settled down in New Delhi.

If the learned Mediator feels that there is no likelihood of settlement, he may send a report to this Court, accordingly.

In order to enable the learned Mediator to establish talks with the parties, the learned counsel on both sides shall file a memo within three days indicating Mobile Phone Numbers and E-mail Ids of both parties.

The matters are directed to be listed immediately after ensuing summer vacation to find out, whether there is a possibility of settlement.

Since, the matters are directed to be listed immediately after summer vacation, there shall be stay of further proceedings before the Courts below until then.
