Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Leave granted.

The respondent writ petitioners, who were seeking admission to D.Ed College, by applying on line as per the admission rules were denied admission cards as they could not make the on line application within closing hours on the last date, for technical reasons beyond their control.

They approached the High Court for directions on the concerned authorities to extend the time, whereupon interim orders were passed on 1.10.2018 pursuant to which they were given admission and have been pursuing the course. If the admissions are now cancelled, the seats will go vacant.

Having regard to the peculiar facts and

circumstances of the case, the impugned order passed by the High Court is set aside. The appellants, who have taken admission, pursuant to the interim orders or otherwise, may be allowed to complete the course.

It is made clear that this order has been passed in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case. This shall not be treated as a precedent.

This appeal is, accordingly, disposed of.
