O R D E R

This contempt petition has been filed submitting *inter alia* that following directions issued by this Court in its order dated 05.02.2019 have not been complied with:

"We direct the State Government and the M.P. State Government and the M.P. State Road Transport Corporation to take a considered decision, whether it would extend the benefit of Fifth Pay Commission, as prayed in the present petition, unfettered by the order passed by the High Court.

Let a considered decision be taken in this regard, at least for the existing employees, within a period of six months."

The documents filed on record show that an appropriate decision has been taken by the concerned authorities.

In the circumstances, it cannot be said that the respondent department or its officials have committed any contempt of the directions issued by this Court.

We, therefore, close the contempt petition.

All other applications stand disposed of without any orders.
