O R D E R

Heard Mr. Harvinder Singh Maan, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

2. The challenge here is to the order dated 29.01.2020 passed by the learned Single Judge in CRM-M-2025 of 2019. It is seen that the action under Section 182 of the IPC was initiated against the petitioner on the recommendation of the Assistant Commissioner of Police, who is a public servant. It is for this reason, the High

Court refused to entertain the petition under Section 482 of the CrPC challenging the Rapat No.12, dated 16.08.2011 at the Police Station, Daresi, District Ludhiana, recommending initiation of proceedings under Section 182 IPC for the false FIR.

3. Having considered the basis for the impugned judgment, we see no reason to interfere. The Special Leave Petition is accordingly dismissed.

4. In view of the dismissal of the SLP preferred by the petitioner, the interim order dated 16.06.2020 staying the proceedings under Section 182 IPC, stands vacated.
