Applications for exemption from filing affidavit and application for impleadment are allowed.

Leave granted.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the counter affidavit and rejoinder affidavit. It is admitted that there are some mistakes in the counter affidavit. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case, more specifically, the position as set out in the rejoinder as also the time the appellant has already been in custody, we consider appropriate to enlarge the appellant on bail on the terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.
