Heard learned counsel for the the parties.

Without going into the merits and without commenting on the allegations made in the transfer petition and having regard to the grounds on which transfer has been prayed for, we are satisfied with the grievance expressed by the petitioner-wife and we accept the same. Therefore, case bearing F. Suit No.1809 of 2017 titled as "Ajit Kumar Khanna Vs. Kavita Parmar" pending before the Family Court No.5, Ahmedabad, Gujarat is ordered to be transferred to the Family Court, Ajmer, Rajasthan.

The case record shall be sent to the transferee Court promptly and without any delay.

After transfer of the case, the transferee Court is directed to make all endeavour for amicable settlement,

failing which for early decision in the case without unnecessary adjournments.

We also direct the Family Court, Ajmer, Rajasthan to ensure that such dates are fixed in the case in a manner that the respondent/husband can attend other proceedings in Ajmer on the same date.

Accordingly, the transfer petition is allowed.
