O R D E R

The application under Section 482, CrPC being pending in the High Court, we are not inclined to entertain the special leave petitions.

The special leave petitions are accordingly dismissed.

We, however, observe that looking into the nature of the order

which has been passed, the High Court shall endeavour to dispose of the application filed under Section 482, CrPC at an early date preferably within a period of three months.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that no order not to file a charge sheet or stop coercive steps could have been passed in exercise of power under Section 482, CrPC. We express no opinion on the above submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioners. All the questions of law are left open.
