- 1 Delay condoned.
- 2 The application filed by the petitioner for grant of interim relief is pending before the Single Judge of the High Court. The Division Bench declined to entertain the Letters Patent Appeal against an order of the Single Judge by which notice was issued. The Division Bench recorded the statement of the counsel for the petitioner that it would suffice if the Single Judge was directed to dispose of the application for interim

relief expeditiously. The Division Bench has directed the Single Judge to dispose of the application for interim relief preferably within one month.

3 The grievance of the petitioner, which is reiterated by Mr Keshav Thakur, learned counsel, is that the application for interim relief has still not been disposed of.

4 We are not inclined to entertain the Special Leave Petition under Article 136 of the Constitution since the application for interim relief is pending consideration before the High Court. The Special Leave Petition is dismissed. However, we request the Single Judge to take up the application for grant of interim relief expeditiously having regard to the time frame which was set out in the order of the Division Bench in the Letters Patent Appeal.
