O R D E R

1. After issuance of notice on 13.05.2020 in the instant transfer petition, the parties were referred to mediation.

2. We are happy to note that the matter was settled before the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre and the settlement agreement dated 06.08.2021 has been placed on record.

3. In terms of the settlement agreement, the parties have agreed to withdraw the proceedings initiated against each other and have also prayed for dissolution of marriage in terms of the settlement arrived at between them.

4. Having gone through the documents placed on record and after having heard learned counsel for the parties, in our view, the case is made out for exercise of powers under Article 142 of the

Constitution of India. We, therefore, allow the prayer made in the applications and declare that the marriage between the parties stands dissolved in accordance with the terms entered into between the parties.

5. The settlement agreement and annexure thereto shall form part of the decree.

6. With these observations, I.A. Nos.36759 and 19696 of 2022 are allowed and the transfer petition stands disposed of.
