The petitioner stood convicted under Section 376 IPC and Section 506 IPC and was sentenced to suffer rigorous imprisonment for seven years and for two years respectively on the aforesaid counts. The conviction and sentence was based on the version of the prosecutrix, a minor and the other material on record. The testimony of the prosecutrix was found to inspire confidence. The assessment made by the High Court was affirmed by this Court while dismissing special leave petition.

We have gone through the review petitions and do not find any error apparent on record to justify interference in our review jurisdiction. This review petition is dismissed.
