O R D E R

The present transfer petition is sought for transfer of Original Matrimonial Suit No. 48 of 2020 filed by the respondent - Amit Kumar Udaypratap Singh under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled as 'Udaypratap Amit Singh Kumar Vs. Geetanjali Singh' now pending in the court of Principal Judge, Family Court at Jamshedpur, Jharkhand to the Court of District Family Court, Pune, Maharashtra.

The parties were referred to the Supreme Court Mediation Centre. Before the Mediation Centre, the parties have agreed to dissolve their marriage on 05.03.2021. A Settlement Agreement signed by the parties and also by the learned counsel representing the parties is available on record. The Learned Counsel for the parties state that parties stand by the settlement agreement so executed.

The respondent-husband shall pay a sum of Rs.6,00,000/- (Rupees Six Lakhs) within 15 days to the petitioner-wife as undertaken by Mr. Jasbir Singh Malik, learned counsel for the

respondent.

In view of the settlement arrived at, the marriage between the parties is ordered to be dissolved by mutual consent by granting a decree of divorce under Section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 read with Article 142 of the Constitution of India.

The transfer petition is dismissed as withdrawn in terms of the settlement dated 5.3.2021 arrived at between the parties.
