**ORDER**

1 This miscellaneous application has been filed for correction of the order of this court dated 9 January 2020, which reads as follows:

“Leave granted.

We have heard the counsel for both the parties.

We set aside the direction contained in para 9 of the judgment of the High Court to deposit the amount of Rs.9,03,650/-(Rupees Nine Lakhs Three Thousand Six Fifty only) deducted towards TDS on the principle amount of Rs.26,45,000/-(Rupees Twenty Six Lakhs Forty Five Thousand only).

The Execution proceedings initiated by the respondent will not be pressed.

We request the High Court to dispose of the pending RSA Nos.2908 and 2909/2016 as expeditiously as possible.

The objections raised by the respondent with respect to the deduction of TDS, and the amount which is deductible, may be

raised before the High Court in the pending R.S.A.

The Civil Appeal is disposed of.”

2 Mr. Saurabh Kirpal appearing for the applicant states that an amount of Rs 9,03,650 was deducted towards TDS on the principal amount of Rs 35,48,650 and hence, the figure of Rs 26,45,000 in the above extract shall have to be corrected to read as Rs 35,48,650.

3 The relief which has been sought in the miscellaneous application is in the following terms:

“Modify the Order dated 09.01.2020 passed in Civil Appeal No.180 of 2020 to the extent that the principle amount which is inadvertently mentioned as Rs.26,45,000/- be corrected as Rs.35,48,650/- which is the actual principle amount”.

4 The miscellaneous application is allowed in terms of prayer (a) quoted above and the figure of Rs 26,45,000 contained in the order dated 9 January 2020, shall stand corrected to read as Rs 35,48,650. The word “principle” shall stand corrected to read as “principal”.
