We have heard Mr. Ankit Goel, learned counsel for the
petitioner and perused the relevant material.

We are not inclined to interfere with the impugned
order. The special leave petition is, accordingly, dismissed.

However, eight weeks' time is granted to the petitioner
to surrender and move for regular bail before the concerned
Trial Court. As and when such prayer for bail is made, it
shall be considered expeditiously.

While considering the regular bail, the Trial Court

shall consider the same on its own merits without being influenced by any of the views expressed by the High Court.

The petitioner shall remain protected for a period of eight weeks or till the date of the order passed by the concerned Court on the bail application.

We make it clear that we have not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case.
