O R D E R

- 1 This transfer petition has been filed by the petitioner-wife for transfer of Application No 139 of 2019 titled "Rajveer Singh Gurjar vs Priti Jadaun" from the Court of Additional District and Sessions Judge, Bandikui, District Dausa, Rajasthan to a court of competent jurisdiction at Dwarka Courts, New Delhi.
- 2 The office report indicates that service is complete, but none has entered appearance on behalf of the sole respondent.
- 3 Having regard to the interests of justice, we are of the view that an order for the transfer of the proceedings is warranted. We accordingly allow the transfer petition and direct that Application No 139 of 2019 titled "Rajveer Singh Gurjar vs Priti Jadaun" be transferred from the Court of Additional District and Sessions Judge, Bandikui, District Dausa, Rajasthan to a court of competent jurisdiction at Dwarka Court, New Delhi
- 4 The transferor court shall forthwith transmit the record of the aforesaid case to the transferee court.

- 5 After transfer of the application, the transferee Court is directed to make all endeavour either for amicable settlement or for early decision in the matter without unnecessary adjournments.

- 6 Pending application(s), if any, stands disposed of.
