O R D E R

Office Report indicates that notice on the sole respondent was served as long back as 20th September, 2019 but no one has entered appearance on his behalf and no counter affidavit has been filed to oppose the prayer made by the petitioner.

In the light of above, heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner-wife and perused the averments made in the instant petition.

Having regard to the averments and considering the ground on which transfer has been prayed for, Original Petition No.1999/2017 and 1217/2018 pending before the Family Court, Ernakulam, Kerala is ordered to be transferred to a competent Court at Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu for hearing and disposal in accordance with law who may try the case himself or transfer the same to the Court competent to do so.
