Leave granted.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

These appeals take exception to the judgment and orders dated 08.01.2020, 13.01.2020 and 08.07.2020 passed by the National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission at New Delhi in IA/18338/2019 in FA/2220/2019, IA/13784/2019 in FA/1716/2019, IA/13781/2019 in FA/1713/2019 and IA/1615/2020 in FA/185/2020 respectively, whereby the Commission has passed conditional interim order in favour

the appellant(s); the condition being the appellant(s) shall deposit entire awarded amount with updated interest within eight weeks.

When these appeals came up for admission, the Court vide orders dated 26.05.2020, 15.06.2020 and 14.10.2020 directed issuance of notice subject to the condition, that 50% of the entire decretal sum along with interest component shall be deposited by the appellants(s) in the respective appeals, in the Registry of the Commission.

In terms of the aforesaid orders, the appellant(s) have already deposited 50% of the entire decretal amount along with interest component. That is not in dispute.

The amount deposited before the Commission can be disbursed/invested by the Commission, subject to hearing both parties on such terms and conditions, as may be necessary.

Suffice it to observe, that in the interest of justice, these appeals need to be disposed of by confirming the interim arrangement noted in orders dated 26.05.2020, 15.06.2020 and 14.10.2020.

Since the appellant(s) have complied with the said condition, the interim relief to continue, until the disposal of the appeals pending before the Commission.

The appeals are disposed of, in the above terms.
