The present Special Leave Petition arises out of an application filed by the Respondent for correction of the year of the Guardians and Wards Act which was allowed by the Family Court. The High Court dismissed the appeal with costs of Rs.5,000/- imposed on the present petitioner for challenging the said application for correction.

We affirm the order passed by the High Court, and direct the petitioner to pay further costs of Rs.10,000/- to the Respondent-daughter-in-law.
