O R D E R

This is a transfer petition at the instance of the petitioner-wife seeking transfer of the case being Matrimonial Suit No.97 of 2016 titled *Sayantana Roy v. Deboshree Kanchan Majumdar (Roy)* pending before 14th Additional District Judge at Alipore, West Bengal to District Judge, Mumbai, Maharashtra.

In view of the above and also considering the hardships which will be faced by the petitioner in contesting the case at Alipore, W.B., we deem it proper to allow the transfer petition and direct transfer of the aforesaid case from the 14th Additional District Judge at Alipore, West Bengal to District Judge, Mumbai, Maharashtra along with all records for its adjudication. The District Judge shall assign the matter to a court of competent jurisdiction.

After transfer of the petition, if the settlement between the parties is not arrived at, the transferee Court is directed to make all endeavour to dispose of the matter within six months without unnecessary adjournments.
