UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

Today when the present Special Leave Petitions were taken up for further hearing, Mr. Ram Niwas Buri, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present Petitions unconditionally.

Dr. Manish Singhvi, learned senior counsel appearing for the respondent-State of Rajasthan has opposed the prayer submitting that, after having taken the benefit under the interim order passed by this Court, the petitioners may not be permitted to withdraw the Petitions. It is submitted that, if this Court permits to withdraw the petitions in that case, it may be clarified that whatever the benefits the petitioners have taken under the interim order passed by this Court, pursuant to our order dated 08.07.2020, shall not be claimed by the petitioners and no benefit shall be accrued to them.

In view of the request made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, we simply permit the petitioners to withdraw the present Petitions unconditionally. The present Special Leave Petitions stand dismissed as withdrawn unconditionally.

However, it is observed and made clear that whatever the benefits that are taken by the petitioners, pursuant to the interim order passed by this Court dated 08.07.2020, the petitioners shall not be entitled to and/or claim any right on the basis of such

benefits granted pursuant to the interim order dated 08.07.2020. It is to be noted even in the order dated 08.07.2020, it was made clear that acceptance of the forms will not furnish any right to the petitioners.

With the above clarifications and observations, the present Special Leave Petitions stand dismissed as withdrawn unconditionally.
