O R D E R

This is a transfer petition at the instance of the petitioner-wife seeking transfer of the case being Matrimonial Case/Civil Suit No.27-A of 2016 titled *Jitendra Kumar Jaiswal v. Gunjan Jaiswal* pending before the Principal Judge, Family Court, Rajnandgaon, Chhattisgarh to Family Court at Balia, U.P.
