We are in agreement with the judgment of the High Court on merits and see no reason to entertain the Special Leave Petition.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that in a Special Leave Petition filed by a co-accused (Amba Lal), namely, Special Leave Petition (Cr1) Diary No 3689 of 2020, on 28 February 2020, the

fine which was enhanced by the High Court was, however, interfered with and the order of the Additional Sessions Judge in regard to the fine was restored.

Following the above view of a coordinate Bench, we direct that the fine shall be as was imposed by the order of the Additional Sessions Judge.

Subject to the aforesaid modification in regard to the fine payable, the Special Leave Petition stands dismissed.
