

UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

The High Court vide its impugned order(s) rejected the anticipatory bail application(s) of the petitioners.

Being aggrieved by this order the petitioners are before this Court.

Admittedly, the Writ Petition(s) for quashment of FIR is pending before the High Court.

We are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order(s) passed by the High Court rejecting the anticipatory bail application(s) of the Petitioners. However, no coercive steps shall be taken against the Petitioners till the disposal of the Writ petition(s) by the High Court.

Petitioners are also at liberty to file fresh application(s) seeking anticipatory bail after the disposal of the Writ Petition(s) by the High Court, if need be.

In case such an application(s) is/are filed, the High Court is requested to consider the same without being influenced by the impugned order(s).

In view of the above, the Special Leave Petitions are disposed of.

Pending applications also stand disposed of.
