Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Ms. Rachana Srivastava, learned counsel appearing for the State of Meghalaya submits that out of 268 candidates who were appointed, services of 249 have been terminated.

Mr. Jaideep Gupta, learned senior counsel appearing for the appellants disputes the above statement.

It is submitted on behalf of the appellants that the CBI inquiry as directed by the learned Single Judge has already been concluded and the report received by the High Court which is lying in a sealed cover. On the other hand, Ms. Rachana Srivastava states that report of the Committee appointed in terms of the impugned order has also submitted its report.

We are of the view that the High Court ought to have a fresh look at the matter in the light of the two reports which have already been submitted and after hearing the parties concerned.

Accordingly, we set aside the impugned order. The matter is remitted back to the Meghalaya High Court for fresh decision in accordance with law.

The Civil appeal is disposed of in above stated terms.

Parties are directed to appear before the High Court for further proceedings on 10.04.2017.
