O R D E R

- 1 The counsel for the petitioner was not present when the Writ Petition was called out on the previous occasion, on 24 August 2020. He continues to remain absent.
- 2 The petition under Article 32 of the Constitution seeks absorption for the petitioner in the transport department of the State of Rajasthan. The petition is misconceived.
- 3 Annexure P-4 indicates that the civil appeal by the RSRTC was allowed by the judgment of this Court. Annexure P-5 indicates that the review was dismissed.

- 4 In the synopsis which has been drafted to the petition, there is a reference to some other proceedings for the partition of land. Similarly the certificate of the Advocate is also in relation to some other proceedings and not related to the issue in the present proceedings. We expect that when a certificate is prepared by an Advocate, it must be with due care, with a sense of responsibility and not in a casual manner as has been done in the present proceedings. There is no merit in the petition.
- 5 The petition is dismissed.
