

been dismissed by the High Court by the order presently under challenge. The High Court has also ordered *status quo ante* and that the name of the appellant before the High Court be re-entered in the record of facts.

Heard Mr. Amol Chitale, learned Advocate in support of the petition.

Since the instant petition arises out of an order of dismissal of application seeking recall, we do not wish to exercise our power under Article 136(1) of the Constitution. This appeal is, therefore, dismissed.

We however request the High Court to take up the second appeal for final hearing. The appeal was filed in the year 2005. It would therefore be fit if the appeal is disposed of in the shortest possible time and preferably within six months of the receipt of copy of this order.

With the aforesaid observations, this Special Leave Petition is dismissed.

Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
