O R D E R
SLP(Cr1) No. 1321/2020

While issuing notice vide order dated 10.02.2020, it was directed that the petitioner shall not be arrested in connection with crime in question.

It is reported that thereafter the investigation has been completed and charge sheet is filed. It is also reported that the learned Trial Court has not been able to commit the case as the petitioner is not appearing before the concerned Trial Court.

Subject to the petitioner appearing before the concerned Trial Court on each and every date of hearing and as directed by the learned Trial Court unless specifically exempted by the concerned Court, order dated 10.02.2020 is made absolute and it is directed that in case of arrest of the petitioner, she shall be released on bail on the terms and conditions that may be determined by the learned Trial Court, over and above the conditions as stipulated hereinabove.

The Special Leave Petition stands disposed of in terms of the above order.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present Special Leave Petition in view of the subsequent development of granting regular bail by the learned Trial Court.
