O R D E R

The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

Having heard learned senior counsel for the petitioner and carefully perusing the record, we are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order passed by the High Court whereby the High Court dismissed the second application for anticipatory bail filed by the petitioner

The special leave petition is, accordingly, dismissed.

However, taking into consideration the present covid situation, we grant four weeks' time to the petitioner to surrender before the concerned trial court and file an application for regular bail. If such an application is filed by the petitioner, the trial court is directed to consider and dispose of the same in

**accordance with law expeditiously.**

**For a period of four weeks, no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioner.**

**However, we direct the petitioner to co-operate with the investigation.**

**As a sequel to dismissal of the special leave petition, all pending interlocutory applications also stand disposed of.**
