O R D E R

Permission to file SLP is granted.

We are not inclined to interfere in the order as the
case has been remitted back to the Trial Court for
decision afresh. However, the observations made by the
High Court with respect to the 1/3rd responsibility of
the son and 2/3rd of the daughters is hereby diluted, as
the daughters have to be heard and thereafter decision
has to be rendered by the High Court.

It is stated before us that the son is in possession of 1 acre of land. Be that as it may, this aspect has to be looked into.

With the aforesaid observations, the special leave petition is dismissed.
