Challenge to the selection of Respondents 7 and 8 was questioned by the Review Petitioner and the issue was considered by the High Court as under:-

“The petitioner has not been able to show that the Ph.D Degree in the subjects possessed by the Respondents 7 and 8 are not the same as required in the advertisement. Therefore, it cannot be said that merely because the respondents 7 and 8 do not have a First Class Master’s Degree in the subject of Bio-Technology, they would be rendered ineligible for selection.”

The High Court having rejected the challenge, the Petitioner had approached this Court. Affirming the view taken by the High Court the Special Leave Petition was dismissed.

We have gone through the Review Petition and do not find any error apparent on record.

This Review Petition is dismissed.
