O R D E R

These Special Leave Petitions have been preferred against the impugned order passed by the High Court of Judicature at Bombay whereby the High Court dismissed the anticipatory bail applications filed by the petitioners under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C.

In the above Special Leave Petitions, this Court, while issuing notice vide orders dated 13.01.2017 and 24.01.2017, *inter alia*, passed the following relief(s) to the petitioners:

"No coercive steps, including arrest, shall be taken against the petitioners in the meantime."

After hearing the learned Senior Counsel/Counsel appearing for the parties at length, we make the afore-said order absolute.

However, the petitioners are directed to cooperate with the investigation as and when called upon.

In case of non-cooperation of the petitioners with the investigating agency, the Respondents can approach this Court for cancellation of the bail.
