O R D E R

Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and perused the impugned judgment and order dated 8th March, 2018 passed by the High Court of Madras, Bench at Madurai.

Vide impugned order the petitioner herein has been directed to hand over peaceful and vacant possession of

the shop in question on the ground that respondent-Municipality has taken a decision to demolish the existing shops as they are in dilapidated condition and to construct new shops and tenders have been called for and the highest bidder has also been awarded a work order.

It is not in dispute that the shop in question is in dilapidated condition and the construction work has to be undertaken. After the new shops are constructed, the petitioner herein shall be given possession of one shop on such terms and conditions as respondent-Municipality may think deem fit and proper.

The petitioner shall hand over the possession of the shop in question within the period of one month from today.

In view of the above, the special leave petitions stand disposed of.
