Leave granted.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, we are satisfied that the conditions that were imposed by the High Court while granting anticipatory bail were too onerous to be complied with by the appellant. The place of residence of the appellant was 222 kilometers away from the concerned police station. The appellant was directed to report every day at 6.30 p.m. before the In-charge, concerned Police Station and he had complied with the same by attending for at least twelve to thirteen days in a span of fifteen days.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, we set aside the condition imposed by the High Court to everyday

appear before the Police Station In-charge since the investigation is over and the charge-sheet has been filed.

However, the appellant shall continue to be on anticipatory bail which was granted earlier till he appears in court and furnishes bail bonds as may be required.

The appeals are allowed to the extent indicated above.
