Heard Mr. Harshit Sethi, the learned counsel for the petitioner. The counsel points out that although notice was served on the sole respondent (husband), none has entered appearance on his behalf nor any counter affidavit has been filed.

The case of the petitioner is that she was thrown out of the matrimonial home at Pune in 2014 and since then she is residing with her minor daughter in her parental home at Indore. She has applied for Maintenance under Section 125, CrPC and the Court at Indore had ordered for Rs.50,000/- maintenance per month, for the petitioner and the minor daughter.

It is further submitted that the petitioner has filed a police Complaint under Section 498A of the IPC and the Domestic Violence Act and the respondent is expected to participate in the said proceedings at Indore.

The petitioner is projected to be dependent on her parents whereas the respondent is said to be an IT professional employed with M/s Tech Mahindra at Pune.

Having considered the above and the fact that the respondent

has failed to enter appearance despite service of notice, I deem it appropriate to allow the Transfer Petition.

Consequently, the M.P. No. 1168 of 2019 titled as *Amritpal Amarjeet Saluja v. Gangadeep Amritpal Saluja*, is transferred from the Civil Judge, Senior Division, Pune to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Indore, Madhya Pradesh. The records be transmitted without any delay.

The transfer petition is allowed with the above order.
