Heard learned counsel for the parties.

We decline to interfere in this special leave
petition. The special leave petition is dismissed
accordingly.

However, we make it clear that it is open to the
petitioners to pursue remedy for delayed release of

compensation amount which issue be decided in accordance with law, if and when such substantive proceedings are taken out by the petitioners.

The argument of the petitioners that they are entitled for rehabilitation under the Scheme formulated by the State Government is being raised, for the first time, before this Court.

If there is any such scheme and if the petitioners qualify to get rehabilitation under that Scheme, are free to pursue that remedy.

We place on record that possession of the subject property has already been taken on 04.02.2021 by the concerned authority and the petitioners have vacated the same.

Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
