The petitioners herein, who are stated to have been married to each other have filed this Writ Petition on 09.03.2020 under Article 32 of the Constitution of India seeking the following prayers:

"a. Issue a Writ, Order, or Direction in the nature of Mandamus thereby directing the Respondents for providing security and safety to the Petitioners and also directing the concerned Respondents not to take any coercive action against the Petitioners in respect of if any FIR or criminal cases registered in the State of Rajasthan or any other State regarding the solemnization of marriage of the Petitioners.

b. Issue a Writ, Order, or Direction in the nature of Mandamus or any appropriate writ thereby directing the Respondents for providing protection to the Petitioners.

c. Pass such other and further orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the interest of justice."
