UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. Arising out of the judgment of remand passed by the High Court, the present special leave petitions have been filed.
2. After hearing learned counsel for the parties at length, we

find that reasoning may not be sound but for ascertaining the percentage and genuineness of the disability, if the remand is directed by the High Court, it may not cause any prejudice to the parties.

3. In this view of the matter, we are not inclined to entertain the present special leave petitions and to interfere with the impugned order passed by the High Court. Accordingly, the special leave petitions stand dismissed. In the facts, the accident is of the year 2009, however, we direct that the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal shall decide the case afresh within a period of four months from the date of the appearance of the parties.

4. The parties present in the Court agree to appear before the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal on 17.12.2025.

5. Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
