Having heard Mr. Vijay Hansaria, learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioners and carefully perusing the material available on record, we find no merit in the Special Leave Petitions.

The Special Leave Petitions are, accordingly, dismissed.

So far as the interest part is concerned, learned Senior counsel submits that the High Court modified the interest rate from 6 % to 9% and he pleads that a clarification be given that the same is simple interest and not compound interest, as the respondents are claiming otherwise.

We are of the opinion that no such clarification is necessary. The petitioners are at liberty to advance their submissions before the Court at the time of execution.
