The Petitioner was found to be a rank trespasser and the matter in that behalf was dealt with by the High Court as under:-

"9. The appellant/defendant is clearly not the owner of the property in suit, by virtue of Ex.PW1/4. Furthermore, an FIR was also registered against one Dewan Singh who allegedly sold the land in question to the appellant defendant claiming himself to be the attorney of the plaintiff/respondent. When the property in question does not belong to the appellant/defendant, he had no authority to be present on the said land and therefore is liable to face consequences."

The view so taken was affirmed while dismissing the Special Leave Petition.

We have gone through the Review Petition and do not find any justification for interference.

This Review Petition is dismissed.
