Heard Mr. Narender Hooda, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioners and Mr. Siddharth Luthra, learned senior counsel appearing for the caveator/Ms. Kavita, who is not party in the instant special leave petition.

Learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioners has drawn our attention to the order passed by this Court dated 23.9.2016 in CC No.16907/2016, wherein this Court has granted liberty to the petitioners to apply for modification of the interim order, which shall be considered on its own merits. He further submits that even though the successful candidates have filed application for modification of the interim order, the application remains pending and matter is listed on 20.4.2017 before the High Court.
