O R D E R

We have heard Mr. Pankaj Sharma, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Ms. Meenakshi Arora, learned senior counsel, who is on caveat on behalf of the defacto complainant.

We are not inclined to entertain the special leave petition. The special leave petition is accordingly dismissed.

However, six weeks' time is granted to the petitioner to surrender and move an application for regular bail before the Trial

Court. Such prayer as and when made shall be considered and decided expeditiously by the Trial Court in accordance with law. The interim protection from arrest granted to the petitioner by the High Court is extended for a period of six weeks or till the bail application is decided by the Trial Court whichever is earlier. The petitioner shall cooperate with the on-going investigation and shall not leave the trial court's jurisdiction.

Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
