O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. We are of the view, that mere filing of this petition is an absolute misuse of the judicial process. The petitioner insists on photographing the bank premises, which is not permissible in terms of the Handbook of Security Instructions.
3. While dismissing the instant petition, we consider it just and appropriate to impose exemplary costs on the petitioner. The instant petition is dismissed with costs, quantified as Rs.50,000/-. The aforesaid costs shall be deposited by the petitioner with the Supreme Court Bar Association, within one month

from today. The Supreme Court Bar Association shall use the funds, deposited by the petitioner, for upgrading its library.

4. If the petitioner does not deposit the aforesaid costs within the stipulated time, the Registry is directed to re-list the matter for recovery of costs.
