No.1611 of 2014 under Section 13 (1) (ia) of Hindu Marriage Act, against the respondent/wife seeking dissolution of marriage. The same was dismissed on 06.12.2021. Aggrieved by the said order, appellant/husband preferred the present appeal. During the pendency of the present appeal, the appellant and the respondent entered into a settlement and resolved the issues out of the Court. The parties are ready to obtain decree of divorce. They have also entered into joint memorandum of compromise, dated 28.04.2025, on the specific terms and conditions mentioned therein. In the light of the same, both the appellant and the respondent shall appear before the Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, Hyderabad, for the purpose of identification and on completion of identification, the Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, Hyderabad, shall submit a report. Learned counsel for the appellant as well as the respondent shall file a copy of the joint memo in the Registry.
