COMMON ORDER :

1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner. Heard learned counsel for the respondent.
2. Both the counsels gave consent for disposal of the main civil revision petition itself.
3. The counsel for the petitioner brings to the notice of this Court that vide order dated 01.07.2022 passed in Civil Revision Petition No. 1458 of 2022, this Court under identical peculiar factual situation considered the application of Rule 18 of Rules for Video Conferencing for Courts in the State of Telangana (the Rules) and in the said case observed at paras 10 and 11 are as follows:

10. In the peculiar facts and circumstances of this case having regard to the time difference between United States of America and India and the difficulties expressed by the parties to secure a

Coordinator, this Court is of the opinion that case is made out to relax the rigours of Rule 8 of the Rules and permit the General Power of Attorney of husband to sign the evidence on his behalf.

11. The petitioner shall appear before the Additional Family Court at Hyderabad tomorrow at 10.30 a.m. The Additional Family Court shall record her statement. At the time of recording the statement of the petitioner, the husband shall be present through Video Conference. After recording the statement of petitioner the statement of respondent shall be recorded. At the time of recording statement of respondent the petitioner and the Power of Attorney of respondent shall be present physically in the Court.

Accordingly, the civil revision petition is disposed of. No costs."

4. Taking into consideration the averments made in the affidavit filed in support of I.A. No. 1 of 2022 in C.R.P.No.1584 of 2022, the same is ordered as prayed for.

5. This Court opines that taking into consideration the view taken by this Court in identical circumstances in

C.R.P.No.1458 of 2022, in its order dated 01.07.2022, the I.A.No.2 of 2022 in C.R.P.No.1584 of 2022 is allowed as prayed for.

6. Accordingly, this Civil Revision Petition stands allowed. There shall be no order as to costs.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed.
