Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the inaction of the respondents 2 and 3 in not acting in pursuance of the Memo issued by the Government dt. 03.07.2021 and further action of the respondents in not considering the representation of the petitioner dt.12.08.2021, 11.02.2022 and 14.02.2022 as being illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional and consequently direct the respondents 2 and 3 to forthwith act on the Memo dt. 03.07.2021 issued by the Government and pass appropriate orders by considering the representation of the petitioner dt.12.08.2021, 11.02.2022 and 14/02/2022.

ORDER:

This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking a writ of mandamus declaring inaction of the respondents No.2 and 3 in considering the representations of the petitioner dated 12.08.2021, 11.02.2022, 14.02.2022 as illegal and arbitrary.

2. The petitioner seems to have made representations to the respondents against one Mohammed Ghouse Shah Quadri for interfering with the performance of the functions of the petitioner as a Qazi. The petitioner seems to have made representations to the respondents and the representation dated 10.02.2022 is made to the 5th respondent. He submits that the representations made by the petitioner have not been considered and there is every likely-hood that the person against whom he has made a complaint of interference with the performance of functions by the petitioner will be appointed as a Qazi.

3. Learned Government Pleader for Minority Welfare submits that the petitioner's representation dated 10.02.2022 will be considered by the respondents in accordance with law.

4. Taking the above submissions of the learned counsel into consideration and having regard to the fact that the petitioner has made representations to the competent authority i.e. 5th respondent, the 5th respondent is directed to consider the representations of the petitioner if there is any proposal to appoint Mohammed Ghouse Shah Quadri as one of the Qazis in the areas in which the petitioner is also performing functions as Qazi.

Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of. No order as to costs.

Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall stand closed.
