Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the respondents particularly the 2nd respondent in not considering the petitioner for counseling and admission into MBBS UG course under Category-B and C in Management Quota for the academic year 2021-22 by receiving the requisite fees as illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional and consequently direct the respondents to consider and include the name of the petitioner in the counseling for admission into MBBS

UG course under category-B and C in Management quota for the academic year 2021-22.

ORDER (Per the Hon'ble Sri Justice A.Rajasheker Reddy)

Aggrieved by the action of 2nd respondent – Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences, Warangal represented by its Registrar, in not considering the case of the petitioner for counseling and admission into MBBS course for the academic year 2021-22 under the Management (B & C) Quota, the present writ petition is filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the *lis* in the present writ petition is squarely covered by the orders passed by this court in W.P.Nos.8410 of 2022 dated 15.02.022, and 13845 of 2022 dated 16.03.2022, and hence similar order may be passed.

Sri A.Prabhakar Rao, learned Standing Counsel appearing for 2nd respondent – University does not dispute the same, and seeks to dispose of the writ petition.

Heard Learned Government Pleader for Medical and Health, and Family Welfare for the 1st respondent.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions of the learned counsel, and the orders of this court, which are referred to above, the present writ petition is disposed of as under:

"The petitioner is permitted to approach the 2nd respondent and submit her application along with original certificates by paying Rs.6,300/- (Rupees six thousand three hundred only) towards registration charges and Rs.7,500/- (Rupees seven thousand five hundred only) towards service provider charges within a period of three days from today.

On receipt of such application, the 2nd respondent shall consider the petitioner under Management (B & C) Quota for the academic year 2021-22 for admission into MBBS UG course in the upcoming / mop-up counseling in accordance with law, and take necessary action thereon."

Interlocutory applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.

No order as to costs.
