a) The action of the respondents in allotting the petitioner to Jagityal District vide proceedings No.ES/SC/KA/ JAGI/SCAS/0190, dated 24.12.2021 is illegal and arbitrary violating article 14 and 16 of the Constitution of India.

b) Declare that the action of the respondents in not considering and disposing of the application of the petitioner dated 24.12.2021 is illegal and arbitrary
