

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE MUMMINENI SUDHEER KUMAR

WRIT PETITION No.21018 of 2022

ORDER:

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for the respondents. With their consent, this Writ Petition is disposed of at the admission stage.

2. The grievance of the petitioner in this Writ Petition is that the Revision Petition No.F2/5205/2017 filed by the petitioner on the file of third respondent is not being taken up for consideration, in accordance with law.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contend that aggrieved by Panchanama dated 01-07-2011, 07-12-2012, 10-11-2014 drafted by the respondent No.5 herein in respect of the land in Ac.01-01 gts., in Sy.No.162 situated at Chakapuram Revenue Village, Nidamnoor Village, the petitioner herein filed a Revision Petition under Section 4 (B) of Andhra Pradesh Assigned Lands (Prohibition of Transfers) Act, 1977.

4. The second respondent herein having taken up the said Revision Petition issued notice dated 02-03-2020 requiring the respective parties to appear on 07-03-2020. However, thereafter, the third respondent failed to take any further action for consideration of Revision Petition and for disposal of the same. Therefore, the petitioner having waited for more than two years, filed the present Writ Petition seeking direction to the third respondent to dispose off the Revision Petition filed by the petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration the fact that the third respondent herein having entertained the Revision Petition filed by the petitioner and already issued notices as early as 02-03-2020 to the respective parties, but the said Revision Petition is said to be still pending and no Orders are passed.

6. In view of the same, this Court is of the view this Writ Petition is disposed off at the admission stage, directing the third respondent/Joint Collector, Nalgonda District, to take up the Revision Petition No.F2/5205/2017 filed by the petitioner

under Section 4 (B) of Andhra Pradesh Assigned Lands (Prohibition of Transfers) Act, 1977 and dispose off the same, by duly issuing notices to all the parties, and giving them reasonable opportunity, and to pass appropriate Orders, in accordance with law, within a period of 8 (Eight) weeks from the date of receipt of this Order and communicate the said Order to the respective parties.

Miscellaneous Petitions, if any, pending in this Writ Petition shall stand closed.
