Learned Counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent Nos.6 and 7 by Registered Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.

Taking into consideration of the fact that by virtue of impugned order the petitioner will be deprived of the family pension and on the other hand sixth and seventh respondents are not entitled to claim the benefit of the family pension of the deceased husband of first petitioner, there shall be interim suspension of the interim proceedings. However, the petitioners shall not use the Family Pension Certificate for any other purpose other than drawing family pension.
