Petition Under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction declaring the allotment and posting of the Petitioner to the Wanaparthi District Local Cadre by the Respondents vide orders bearing Proc. No. ES/ES/MA/WANA/SCAS/0762 dt.21/12/2021 and Proc. No. ES/SC/WANA/SCAS/0022 dt. 06/01/2022 and continuation in the same cadre as being illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional, in violation of the principles of natural justice, in violation of Memo No. 1655/SPF-1/2021-8 dated 24/12/2021 and in violation of Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently to set aside the same and direct the Respondents to allot the Petitioner to a school in the Ranga Reddy District Local Cadre.
